

**FOOTHILL-DE ANZA COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT
RESOLUTION NO. 2016-14**

**ADOPT CALIFORNIA UNIFORM PUBLIC CONSTRUCTION
COST ACCOUNTING ACT (UPCCAA) PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, prior to the passage of Assembly Bill No. 1666, Chapter 1054, Statutes 1983, which added Chapter 2, commencing with §22000, to Part 3 of Division 3 of the Public Contract Code, existing law did not provide a uniform cost accounting standard for construction work performed by local public agencies; and

WHEREAS, Public Contract Code §§22000 et seq., the Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (the "Act") establishes such a uniform cost-accounting standard;

WHEREAS, the Act provides for the implementation of uniform, construction cost accounting procedures and informal bidding procedures for all public agencies electing to participate, together with instructions for their adoption and implementation by such public agencies;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Contract Code §§22010 and 22017, the California Uniform Construction Cost Accounting Commission (the "Commission") developed and recommended to the California State Controller uniform construction cost accounting and informal bidding procedures (the "Uniform Procedures"), consistent with the Public Contract Code §§22031 and 22017, for consideration;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Contract Code §22019, the California State Controller adopted the Uniform Procedures;

WHEREAS, the Act only applies to a public agency whose Board of Trustees has by resolution elected to become subject to the uniform procedures and has notified the California State Controller of that election;

WHEREAS, California community college districts are eligible to adopt the uniform procedures pursuant to the Act;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Foothill-De Anza Community College District ("District") has determined that it is in the best interests of the District to elect to become subject to the uniform procedures for maintenance and public works projects;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Contract Code §22030, the Board of Trustees of the Foothill-De Anza Community College District ("District") formally elects to become subject to the procedures set forth in the Act and to the California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Commission policies and procedures manual and cost-accounting review procedures.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Trustees of the Foothill-De Anza Community College District hereby resolves as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals are all true and correct.

Section 2. That the District hereby, pursuant to Public Contract Code §22030, elects to become subject to the uniform procedures set forth in the Act and to the

Commission's policies-and-procedures manual and cost accounting review procedures, as they may each from time to time be amended, and directs District staff to notify the California State Controller of this election.


Section 3. That repair, maintenance, and public projects undertaken by the District, as defined by the Act in accordance with the limits listed in Public Contract Code §22032, may be entered into contract by informal procedures as set forth in Public Contract Code §22034.

Section 4. That the Vice Chancellor of Business Services, Director of Purchasing Services, Senior Buyer – Special Projects, or other as designated by the Board of Trustees is authorized to award contracts for repairs, maintenance, and public projects pursuant to this resolution.
